Parents, we are delighted to offer a youth program that provides educational information and activities for your children to learn more about sustainable agriculture and the many economics opportunities available on their farm.

We have scheduled many fun activities and workshops for your children to participate in. This year, we encourage you to bring the entire family to the Lied Lodge & Conference Center: <http://www.liedlodge.org> check out all the fun activities for your family.

There is an Olympic-sized indoor pool at Lied Lodge, which is open daily from 6:30am to 11:00pm, and is reserved exclusively for Lied Lodge guests. Because of the swimming pool and outdoor trails we are asking parents to help us keep your children safe. We want to make sure there are no accidents or children getting lost on the trails. To help us do this please read the following:

- ★ Let Bev know when you register what workshops you are planning to attend. If you change your mind and want to go to another workshop then please go to your child's workshop and inform them of where you will be. This way if your child needs you - we can find you.
- ★ If your child does not want to stay for the entire workshop then one of our volunteers will bring them to your workshop – this way we know your child is with you and accounted for.
- ★ Make sure to pack lots of warm clothing: gloves, hats and boots for your child to participate in outdoor activities with the Arbor Day Tree Adventure.
- ★ From COLD to HOT make sure you bring their swimsuits so they can enjoy the kiddy wading or Olympic-sized indoor pool. Please make sure they are being supervised and not left alone.
- ★ **If your child has any ALLERGIES – make sure you tell Bev when you call to register. Snacks will be served in several of the workshops.**
- ★ If you are in a workshop or at a booth and your child is **not attending** any workshops or activities they must be with an adult or an older sibling (we recommend the older child be at least 10 years old).
- ★ If you have children 4 years old and under and need daycare please let Bev know when you call to register.
